
Listen to the stories **Elmer** and **Winnie the Witch** on Espresso.

## **Colour sensory bottles:**

Using clear juice bottles, put coloured objects in each bottle (making sure you screw the lid on tight so they don't come out)

You may want to use:

- Coloured buttons;
- Water and food colouring,
- Coloured water and cooking oil,
- Cotton wool,
- Coloured pasta,
- Coloured rice
- Craft items such as pipe cleaners
- Natural objects from the garden



## **Colour sorting:**

Can you sort your toys into different colours. How many red cars do you have? How many yellow bricks do you have? Put the toys in different piles.

### Threading:

Do you have any colourful beads that you could make a rainbow necklace with?

If not by not paint some penne pasta to thread with?



### Windy day streamers

Use a stick from the garden and tie some strips of fabric/ribbon or any other light weight materials you have at home.

Go outside and enjoy watching the wind blow the streamers in your hand.

No twigs? Why not use a toilet or kitchen roll tube.
