Telford and Wrekin Coronavirus update: Take up your vaccination!

With cases rising locally and nationally, our focus is on getting people vaccinated.

If you are aged 18 and over and you haven't had your first dose yet, don't delay it - it significantly reduces your risk of getting seriously ill or dying from Covid-19:

Book your appointment online or by calling 119 or
Walk-in to a vaccination clinic (no appointment needed). Check clinic opening times and eligibility.

Make sure you get vaccinated twice, as two doses provide much greater protection than one.

If you've had your 1st dose at a walk-in vaccination centre, you can book your 2nd dose using the national booking service. You'll need to wait 24 hours after your 1st dose before you can book.

GETTING A COVID-19 TEST in Telford and Wrekin



You MUST get a test if:

You have at least **one** of the three main symptoms.



High temperature



New persistent cough



Loss of taste or smell

ISOLATE as soon as symptoms show, while waiting for test results and if you test positive.

You **CAN** get a test for these precautionary symptoms:



Headaches



Aches and pains



Feeling very tired for no good reason



Sore throat



Runny nose



Sneezing



Tummy ache in children

You **DO NOT NEED TO ISOLATE** if you have **only one or more of these precautionary symptoms**, or while waiting for test results for these precautionary symptoms.

You only need to isolate if you test positive or have at least one of the three main symptoms.

Book a test at nhs.uk/coronavirus

For precautionary symptoms testing select:

'My local council or health protection team has asked me (or someone I live with) to get a test, even though I do not have symptoms.'
