## Let's Celebrate Me

### Baby room:

We have enjoyed meeting and greeting all our new parents and children to our baby room this week. Please feel free to call or message on iconnect if there is any questions you still may have.

Over the next 5 weeks we will be exploring the new environment and learning about ourselves, families and making friends.

This week we will be exploring our faces in the mirrors, exploring where facial features are and singing 'heads, shoulders knees and toes' to look at other parts of our bodies.

We will be reading the story 'peekaboo' and seeing if the children can close their eyes and repeat the word 'boo' joining in with a game.

We have created a home from home role play are where the children can investigate items from home such as cups and plates, dressing up clothing and pretending to bake in kitchen. We will be looking at how to mix ingredients in a bowl with a spoon.

We will be investigating our senses by smelling and touching lemons and limes in warm water and tasting new fruit and vegetables at snack times.

### **Toddler Room**

This week in the toddler room we will be sharing the story "Goldilocks and the three bears". In the home corner we will be setting the table for the three bears. Talking about the different sizes we can see. I wonder which is the big chair? On the mark making table we will be practicing our pencil control creating different lines for a shopping list.

On the finger gym we will be exploring filling and emptying porridge oats into different sized bowls. In the art studio we will be introducing texture and movement. Where we will be exploring finger painting using one colour at a time. Then I wonder what will happen when we combine two colours together on our paper?

Our rhyme of the week is Ring a ring a roses and 1,2,3,4, come and sit down on the floor.






