## Our theme in nursery this term is called:

## Let's Celebrate Autumn

## **Baby Room**

Next week in the Baby room we will be focussing on the following stories







We will be continuing to use our fine motor skills to explore and pick up sweetcorn. 'I wonder what you can feel and see?'

The children will investigate sensory tubs with autumn leaves, pine cones and different coloured water alongside sorting treasure baskets. Adults will be modelling language through play. Can the children babble and say single clear words?

We will be getting creative printing with leaves and apples in autumnal colours and going on a treasure hunt outside to collect leaves, sticks and pebbles in our treasure hunt bags. We will explore mark marking using brushes in water and chalks on the chalk board.





#### **Toddler Room**

Next week in the toddler room we will be learning about road safety. We will be listening and dancing to the "stop look and listen" song. We will be creating roads out of black playdough and moving the cars on top to create tracks.

In the art studio we will be creating traffic lights with the paints talking about red means stop and green is go. We will also be exploring moving the cars into the paint and talking about the marks they leave on the paper.

Outside on the playground we will be practising holding hands to cross the zebra crossing, talking about how we hold an adult's hand near the road and on the carpark.

Our song of the week is "I'm driving in my car"



#### **Preschool Room**

Next week in pre-school we will be continuing with the theme 'Let's Celebrate Autumn'.

It is 'Road Safety Week' so in the playdough the children will be exploring marks made by vehicles. Outside the children will be learning how to stay safe near the road and how to cross the road.

In the maths area the children will be sorting big and little leaves and in the art area they will be able to make autumn collages like Andy Goldsworthy.

Our rhyme of the week is 'Five little Leaves'


