Our theme in nursery this term is called:

Let's Celebrate Autumn

Baby Room

This week the children will be making sounds and going on a leaf hunt outside. We will be exploring coloured dough and using the items collected from home and the outside environment to make marks in playdough, adding sticks to make hedgehogs and using their hands and fingers to make marks.



We will be exploring autumnal objects in the treasure baskets using our senses to investigate texture and smell.



We will be going on a colour hunt in the baby room to collect orange objects, adult's will model language for children to hear, point and babble through play. Lets explore size in the role play area. 'Show me the big cup, show me the little cup and arranging objects inside one another to explore size of objects.

Toddler Room

This week in the toddler room we will be continuing to celebrate the Autumn season.

We will be sharing the story "leaf hunt" and encouraging the children to join in with the repeated phrases from the story. Then we will be going on our own leaf hunt in the garden, where we will also be sorting and talking about the different leaves we find

On the playdough table we will be creating our own hedgehogs using different tools to create their spines.

On the finger gym we will be picking up leaves with the tweezers. I wonder how many leaves you can collect?

> Our nursery rhyme of the week is "Shake, shake the apple tree"



Preschool Room

This week in preschool we will be continuing our theme of 'Autumn'.

On the playdough table we are making hedgehogs with spikey sticks and in the art area we are creating collages with natural objects.

We are also starting to rehearse our songs for the Nativity.

Our rhyme of the week is 'Leaves are falling' and 'One potato, two potatoes, three potatoes, four'.


